Has Eversource obtained landowner permission to access the ROW from Evergreen Terrace?

Response:

Eversource has existing easement rights that allow it access to the ROW from Evergreen Terrace using the access route depicted on 1975 Line D&M Plan Volume 3 map sheet 2 of 3. Eversource has discussed the access route with one of the two affected property owners, and the owner has no concerns. Eversource also attempted multiple times to contact the second property owner to discuss the project, but has not yet received a response. The project and access route had been discussed with the previous owner of this property, which was sold at the end of April 2016.

If a helicopter is not available for conductor pulling activities, Eversource proposes to clear vegetation through the center of the ROW and use a light duty vehicle to pull rope. Could Eversource designate this area temporary and restore it consistent with Eversource's BMPs? If not, explain.

Response:

If Eversource cannot use a helicopter for the conductor pulling work, then the continuous road as described in the company's filed D&M plan would be temporary and the area where the road was located would be restored in accordance with Eversource's BMPs.
