Dear Ms. Bachman:

On October 28, 2016, the undersigned on behalf of TRS Fuel Cell, LLC (“TRS”), owner of the above-referenced project (the “Project”), submitted its (i) final site plan and (ii) security fence detail, in accordance with condition 4 of the Council’s September 6, 2016 decision letter.

Included in its October 28, 2016 submittal, TRS stated, in part, “From where the Alumi-Gard fence ends, to the corner of Triangle Street and Starr Street, TRS will erect an eight (8)-foot high chain link fence.” That statement was made in error and the purpose of this letter is to correct and clarify that statement.


The fence from the fuel cell facility (where the Alumi-Gard fence ends) to the corner of Triangle Street and Starr Street is extraneous to the Project and unrelated to the fuel cell operations. The property owner, J.A.R. Associates, intends to erect this fence. TRS is advised that J.A.R. Associates will seek permit approval from the City of Danbury prior to building its fence.

The undersigned apologizes to the Council and to the City of Danbury for any confusion that the October 28, 2016 filing may have caused.
