Your letter of December 16, 2015 was forwarded to me from HPC Wireless Services. As noted, American Tower Corporation (“ATC”) and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (“AT&T”) have not provided confirmation that conditions in the approval of Petition No. 1108 have been met.

As of this date, the work approved in the Petition has not been completed. AT&T has informed ATC that its plans for the site have been placed on hold, and AT&T does not anticipate that the site will be implemented during 2016. Accordingly, neither the tower and foundation reinforcement and modification nor the compound expansion has been undertaken.
