RE: **PE1133-CING-20160829** – New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC sub-petition for a declaratory ruling for approval of an eligible facility request for modifications to an existing telecommunications facility located at 500 Queen Street, Southington, Connecticut.

Dear Attorney Laub:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) hereby approves your Eligible Facilities Request (EFR) to install antennas and associated equipment at the above-referenced facility pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission Wireless Infrastructure Report and Order, with the following conditions:

1. Prior to commencement of installation, AT&T shall provide one copy of the Structural Analysis Report to the Council referencing Revision G of the *Structural Standards for Steel Antenna Towers and Antenna Supporting Structures* as adopted by the Connecticut State Building Code effective October 1, 2016;
2. Reinforcements shall be made in accordance with the structural analysis report and associated drawings prepared by Paul J. Ford & Company dated August 4, 2016 and stamped by Justin Kline or subsequent structural analysis report in accordance with Revision G as stated in the condition above;
3. Within 45 days following completion of equipment installation, AT&T shall provide documentation certified by a Professional Engineer that its installation complied with the recommendations of the structural analysis;
4. Within 45 days after completion of construction, the Council shall be notified in writing that construction has been completed;
5. Any nonfunctioning antenna and associated antenna mounting equipment on this facility owned and operated by the Petitioner shall be removed within 60 days of the date the antenna ceased to function;
6. The validity of this action shall expire one year from the date of this letter; and
7. The Petitioner may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one year deadline provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 60 days prior to the expiration.

This decision is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Council and is not applicable to any other modification or construction. All work is to be implemented as specified in the EFR dated August 26, 2016.
