RE: **PETITION NO. 1140** – Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed reconductoring of a portion of an existing 115-kV transmission line extending from Barbour Hill Substation in South Windsor to Manchester Substation in Manchester, Connecticut and modifications to Barbour Hill Substation and Manchester Substation.

Dear Ms. Taylor:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your email of April 6, 2016 regarding construction work on Sunday, April 10, 2016 from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM to take place during a scheduled outage. Council staff hereby approves Sunday construction work to occur on April 10, 2016 and, in the case of inclement weather on April 10th, Sunday construction work is also approved on April 17, 2016.

The Sunday construction work is required to complete underground cable terminations at a transmission structure outside of the Barbour Hill Substation in South Windsor that Eversource crews have not been able to complete due to inclement weather.

This approval applies only to the Sunday construction work hours requested on April 6, 2016 and includes the days and hours stated above.
