Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 16-501(e), I enclose copies of the materials that The United Illuminating Company ("UI") provided to the Town of Trumbull, City of Bridgeport and Town of Stratford (collectively, "the Municipalities") concerning UI's proposed substation in Trumbull (the "Project").

The following documents were provided to the Municipalities by UI:

1. Materials distributed at a meeting with the town officials and residents who live near the proposed site on May 10, 2006: (i) proposed Trumbull Substation – Fact Sheet – May 10, 2006; (ii) color photorenderings; and (iii) color photorenderings from Environmental Report, Trumbull Substation Project, prepared by Black & Veatch, October 2005.
2. Letter dated May 26, 2006 to Julie Kohler regarding photorenderings and suggested use of Site 6.
3. Letter dated March 6, 2006 from Eugene Kallaur to Robert Mack regarding full scale topographic map of substation plan.
4. Email memorandum dated February 2, 2006 from Kathleen Shanley to First Selectman Baldwin regarding contacting abutters to the proposed site and other Project information.
5. Letter dated December 21, 2005 from Richard Reed to Mayor Miron (Stratford) describing the Project and initiating the municipal consultation period.



6. Letter dated December 21, 2005 from Richard Reed to Mayor Fabrizio (Bridgeport) describing Project and initiating the municipal consultation period.
7. Letter dated November 28, 2005 from Richard Reed to First Selectman Baldwin (Trumbull) describing the Project and initiating the municipal consultation period.
8. Municipal consultation materials/reports: (i) Capacity Expansion Alternatives for the Trumbull/Shelton Area, prepared by EPRI Solutions, June 20, 2005; (ii) Trumbull Substation Site Selection Study, prepared by George Eldridge, revised June 8, 2005; (iii) Environmental Report, Trumbull Substation Project, prepared by Black & Veatch, October 2005; (iv) Facility Noise Assessment, Trumbull Substation Project, prepared by Black & Veatch, July 13, 2005; (v) EMF Assessment for the Proposed Trumbull Substation, prepared by Eneritech Consultants, August 17, 2005.

UI met with representatives from Trumbull before the distribution of the municipal consultation filing. The formal municipal consultation process began on December 1, 2005 when the filing was delivered to Trumbull's Chief Elected Official. Additionally, on December 22, 2005 and December 28, 2005, UI delivered the municipal consultation filing to the municipal consultation filing to the Chief Elected Officials in Stratford and Bridgeport.
