



Development and Management Plan
Staff Report
July 3, 2007

On March 13, 2007, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) issued a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need to Message Center Management, Inc. (MCM) for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a monopole wireless telecommunications facility located at the Norfolk "Town Farm" parcel off Route 44 in Norfolk, Connecticut. As required in the Council's Decision and Order, MCM submitted a Development and Management Plan to the Council for the approved facility on June 25, 2007.

Consistent with the Council's Decision and Order, MCM would construct a 180-foot monopole capable of supporting five levels of platform mounted antennas. Cingular Wireless would install six panel antennas on a platform at a centerline height of 180 feet above ground level (agl). The top of the facility with antennas would be 183 feet agl. Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless would install 12 panel antennas at a centerline height of 160 feet above ground level.

MCM would construct a 60-foot by 100-foot equipment compound enclosed by an eight-foot high chain link fence. Cingular Wireless would install a 12-foot by 20-foot equipment shelter on a concrete slab within the compound. Verizon Wireless would install a 12-foot by 30-foot equipment shelter within the compound.

Access to the site would be from an existing gravel road extending from Route 44 to the north side of the Town's outdoor storage yard. A new 60-foot long, 15-foot wide access road would be constructed from the storage yard to the compound.

Utility service to the compound would be installed overhead along the existing gravel drive to the south side of the outdoor storage yard. From the storage yard, utilities would be routed underground 530 feet to the compound. No landscaping around the facility is proposed due to the remote location of the site.

Site development would require moderate clearing and significant grading. Erosion and sedimentation controls would be installed around the compound development area and around a wetland that is located to the west of the existing gravel road. The only work required near the wetland is the installation of utility poles.

Consistent with the Council's Decision and Order, the cumulative worst-case radio frequency power density level at the base of the tower would be 6.9% of the applicable ANSI standard.

All of the Development and Management Plan requirements set forth in the Council's Decision & Order for Docket 320 are substantially in compliance; therefore, Council staff recommends approval.
