RE: Docket 320 –Message Center Management,, Inc. and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC
for a certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction,
maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located off Greenwoods
Road East (U.S. Route 44), Norfolk, Connecticut.

The Department of Transportation (D.O.T.) has reviewed the above-mentioned Docket and has
the following comment.

- 1.) If the proposed project requires access to Route 44 or would require any work within
the Route 44 right of way, then the applicant must obtain an encroachment permit
pursuant to the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, Section 13b-17-1. The
District 2 Permit office will need to review a complete set of construction plans
which shows all work within the highway, all site work, any required easements and
standard details for highway construction prior to issuing the permit.

The District Permit Office will determine the bond amount, insurance coverage,
maintenance and protection of traffic, inspection, roadway restoration and pavement
restoration requirements.
