

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50f (b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations pertaining thereto, of an application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (the "Application") to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on or about September 22, 2006 by Optasite, Inc. ("Optasite") and Omnipoint Communications, Inc., a subsidiary of T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("Omnipoint" or T-Mobile") (together the "Applicants"). The Applicants have identified two sites for the proposed facility both located at 12 Orchard Drive, Ledyard, Connecticut (the "Property"). The Application proposes to construct a 150 foot tall steel monopole and associated equipment within a 50' by 50' fenced compound (the "Facility") located within an approximately 144-acre property located off of Orchard Drive in the Gales Ferry section of Ledyard. This property is owned by Richard H. and Diane Y. Homberg and currently under agricultural use as an orchard.

At either Site at the Property, the Applicants propose a monopole telecommunications facility extending approximately 150 feet, and appurtenant base station equipment located within a fenced compound in a 50' by 50' lease area. The monopole and compound area at either location will be designed to accommodate use by four carriers. The compound area at either location will be enclosed by an 8-foot high security fence. The location and other features of the proposed Facility are subject to change under provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §§ 16-50g to 16-50z, inclusive.

The Facility is proposed to eliminate coverage gaps in Omnipoint's network plan to provide personal wireless communications services in New London County, and will also accommodate antennas and equipment of other wireless carriers. The proposed Facility will provide service along State Route 12 and the Thames River in Gales Ferry section of Ledyard and Preston, as well as adjacent residential areas.

Weather permitting, the Applicants will raise a balloon at a representative height on from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. on the day of the Council's first hearing session on the Application, or at a time otherwise specified by the Council.
