
Several months ago, Omnipoint Communications, Inc. ("Omnipoint" or "T-Mobile") notified the Town of Preston of its intent to submit to the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") a proposal for a wireless telecommunications tower facility in Ledyard. At that time, in compliance with Connecticut General Statutes Section 16-50l, Omnipoint provided technical information for two alternate locations off of Orchard Drive in Ledyard, which are within 2500 feet of the Preston town line. Either alternative would involve construction of a 150' tall tower and related equipment space in a fenced compound.

Thereafter, Omnipoint filed its application with the Council and processing of the application commenced. In June, 2006, Omnipoint withdrew the application to afford new project personnel an opportunity to address questions posed by the Council.

I am writing at this time to notify you that the application will be resubmitted on or about September 15, 2006. Omnipoint and Optasite, Inc., a tower developer active in Connecticut, will apply jointly to the Council. Optasite would hold the Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the site, should the Council grant approval for one of the two locations, and Omnipoint would install its antennas and equipment at the site. The proposed project details, including location and tower height, are unchanged.
