Pursuant to the provisions of Public Act 03-140, AN ACT CONCERNING LONG-TERM PLANNING FOR ENERGY FACILITIES, please be advised that the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the sum of \$25,000 as payment to the Municipal Participation Account in connection with the above-referenced proceeding. This payment was received on December 15, 2006, and deposited into your department account (OTT14420) in fund 12060 – “Other Restricted Revenue”.

Section 16 of the Act states, in part, that “[p]ayments from the account shall be made upon authorization by the State Treasurer...” and provides guidance in the event an application involves more than one municipality. To that end, please note that the above-referenced proceeding required notice be sent to one municipality - Oxford. This municipality may apply for any or all of the Fund amount designated for this project.




