

NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-501(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 16-501-1(e) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies of an Application to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council (“Siting Council”) on February 9, 2007 or thereafter by Optasite Towers LLC and Omnipoint Communications, Inc., a subsidiary of T-Mobile USA, Inc. (“T-Mobile”) (collectively the “Applicants”). The Applicants will request a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need from the Siting Council for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility in Meriden, Connecticut. The Applicants are proposing to construct a new monopole tower at 651 Paddock Avenue, Meriden, Connecticut and is owned by First Assembly of God Church of Meriden, Inc. (the “Property”). The Applicants propose to construct a new 120’ self-supporting stealth monopole tower, antennas, associated equipment and other site improvements integral to a wireless communications facility. The location, height and other features of the proposed facility are subject to review and potential change under provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50g *et. seq.*

The proposed facility would provide personal wireless communication service in the City of Meriden Route 15 and the surrounding area. The Application will explain the need, purpose and benefits of the facility and will also describe the environmental impacts of the proposed facility.

A balloon representative of the proposed height will be flown on the day of the Siting Council public hearing on the Application, which will take place in the City of Meriden. The balloon will be flown from approximately 12 p.m. to 5 p.m. Notice of the public hearing date will be provided by the Siting Council.
