Re: Transfer of Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need
(Community Antenna Television Headend – 689 Old Colchester Road,
Montville, CT)

Dear Attorney Bachman:

I am writing on behalf of Atlantic Broadband Finance, LLC and Atlantic Broadband (CT) LLC (collectively, "Atlantic Broadband") relative to the Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (the "Certificate") previously granted to MetroCast Communications of Connecticut, LLC ("MetroCast") by the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") for the community antenna television headend facility located at 689 Old Colchester Road in Montville, Connecticut (the "Facility").

By Decision and Order in Docket No. 335 dated July 26, 2007, the Council directed that the Certificate, as provided by General Statutes § 16-50k, be issued to MetroCast for the expansion and operation of the Facility¹. Pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement dated June 6, 2015, MetroCast and Atlantic Broadband agreed to a transaction in which MetroCast's assets, including the Certificate, will be transferred to Atlantic Broadband upon closing². By Final Decision on August 12, 2015, the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority approved the transfer.³

Accordingly, as of the closing, Atlantic Broadband (CT) will own and be responsible for the Facility, and requests that the Council's records be revised to so reflect. Atlantic Broadband agrees to comply with the terms, limitations, and conditions contained therein, and represents that the transfer was not contemplated or prior to the time the Certificate was issued.
