

1. How many of the return receipts for the notices sent to abutting landowners did MetroCast receive? If some return receipts were not received, did MetroCast make other attempts to notify the landowners? If yes, explain.
2. What does MetroCast's current programming consist of? How many channels does MetroCast offer now? How many channels would MetroCast offer after the proposed expansion?
3. The application narrative refers to the 689 Old Colchester Road property as being 8.3 acres. On the site plan it is listed as 8.75 acres. Which is correct?
4. Would MetroCast continue to have offices at 67 Myrock Avenue after the proposed expansion at 689 Old Colchester Road?
5. How far and in what direction is the nearest residence to the facility at 689 Old Colchester Road? Who owns this property?
6. How does MetroCast currently receive its programming?
7. The project costs enumerated in Exhibit 2 total more than \$577,000. What are the correct costs?
8. Would MetroCast have any source(s) of backup power at its expanded facility? If so, what would MetroCast use for this backup power?
