

Response


Yes. On May 30, 2007 and July 27, 2007 e-mails were sent to legal counsel for T-Mobile, AT&T Wireless and Sprint Nextel regarding the proposed Bloomfield Blue Hills facility and the Goshen facility. To date, no other carrier has expressed an interest in the proposed Goshen tower.

Question No. 19

Did any of the boards or commissions of the Town of Goshen conduct any meetings about this proposal or issue any statements or recommendations regarding it? If so, provide such documentation.

Response

As discussed in the Application, Cellco presented the Goshen tower proposal at a combined meeting of the Planning and Zoning Commission and Board of Selectmen. To date, Cellco has received a letter from First Selectman Robert Valentine regarding the Town's desire to share the proposed tower. On June 14, 2007, Ms. Carter responded to the Town's letter, confirming that Cellco would make space available on the tower for municipal and emergency service antennas at no extra cost to the Town of Goshen. A copy of Mr. Valentine's letter is included behind Tab 3 and a copy of Ms. Carter's response is included behind Tab 4.

Thank you very much for your June 5, 2007 letter regarding our proposed telecommunications facility off North Street in Goshen. As we discussed at the May 1, 2007 Board of Selectmen's meeting, if this tower site is approved by the Connecticut Siting Council, Verizon Wireless would make space available on the tower for municipal and emergency service antennas at no cost to the Town of Goshen. Prior to construction of the facility we would coordinate with the Town of Goshen and would be willing to install the Town's equipment at our cost provided the installation is completed at the same time site contractors are constructing the facility. We will work out those details once we get closer to the time period within which construction is likely to commence.
