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

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PRE-HEARING INTERROGATORIES

DOCKET NO. 338 – CROMWELL

SPRINT NEXTEL CORPORATION

JULY 27, 2007

1. Provide the drive test data described on page 13 of the Application.
2. What is the scale of the coverage plots behind Tab 9 of the Application?
3. When did Sprint Nextel establish a search area for the proposed site? Provide a diagram depicting the initial search ring.
4. What is the diameter of the proposed flagpole tower? If not known, provide an estimate based on similar installations.
5. Provide Sprint Nextel's Federal Communications Commission licensed frequency bands for the iDEN network serving the Cromwell area
6. Provide the cost of the antennas and radio equipment.
7. Provide the percentage of dropped calls and percentage of ineffective attempts originating from adjacent sites. What is the percent threshold that would trigger resolution?
8. How many residences are within a 1,000-foot radius of the proposed tower?
9. Provide a composite coverage plot, using the scale of the plots behind Tab 9, that depict coverage from the proposed site at an antenna height of 65/59 feet and adjacent sites.
10. Does Sprint Nextel currently use fuel cells as an emergency power source at any of its Connecticut tower sites? If yes, identify such sites?
11. Does Sprint Nextel intend to install a fuel cell at any existing or future sites in Connecticut?
12. Would the tower be an aviation hazard?
