CELLCO PARTNERSHIP

SEPTEMBER 6, 2007

1. Discuss Cellco's need for the proposed facility. Specifically, what level of coverage does Cellco currently have in this area, and in what ways would the proposed facility improve the existing level of service?
2. What is Cellco's operating frequency and the minimum signal level threshold for this area?
3. Provide antenna specifications, including type, make, size, model, number of channels, and maximum power output. What is the proposed antenna height and the number of antennas to be installed.
4. Provide a multi-signal level propagation plot at a scale of 1:40,000, depicting coverage from all existing and/or approved Cellco sites in the area. Provide a brief description of the existing sites including location, distance to the proposed facility, facility type, and antenna height. Depict and label major roads on the plot.
5. Provide a multi-signal level propagation plot, at a scale of 1:40,000, depicting coverage from existing sites and the proposed site. Depict and label major roads on the plots.
6. Provide specifications of the equipment building or cabinets to be installed at the proposed site. What type of emergency power system will be used at the site?
7. Did Cellco have a search ring in this area prior to the filing of this application? If so, provide a map depicting the search ring and describe the properties and/or structures identified for possible use.
