

TELECOMMUNICATION FACILITY NOTICE

Pursuant to Section 16-50l(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut and Section 16-50l-1(e) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, notice is hereby given that on or about January 10, 2007, Sprint Nextel Corporation ("Sprint") will file an application with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Siting Council"). The application will request a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunication facility in Cromwell, Connecticut (the "Application"). The location under consideration is owned by One-Sixty West Street, LLC and is located at 160 West Street (Parcel ID No. 00033900). The facility will have an 80-foot monopole disguised as a flagpole with telecommunications equipment at its base. The Application will explain the need, purpose and benefits of the facility and will also describe the environmental impacts of the facility.

After Sprint files the Application, the Siting Council will set a date to hold a public hearing in the community. The Siting Council will publish notice of the public hearing in the local newspaper and Sprint will post a sign at the site with the details of the public hearing. On the day of the public hearing Sprint will fly a balloon at the site, weather permitting, so the public can ascertain the visibility of the facility.




