I would like to thank you for the opportunity to meet with you on May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2007 to discuss the proposed telecommunications facility located at Rich Road, Thompson.

Due to the fact that the Town has not articulated any opposition or intention to conduct public meetings on this application, we respectfully request that the Town waive its 60-day consultation period so that we can file our formal application with the Connecticut Siting Council. Please note that waiver of this period will not affect the rights of the residents or the Town to voice their opinions on the matter. Each of the abutting landowners will still receive notice of the filing of the application and the Siting Council, pursuant to its regulations, will still conduct a public hearing regarding the application in Thompson where all members of the public will have an opportunity to voice their opinions regarding the application.
