



1. Manner in which petitioner claims to be substantially and specifically affected: **This proposed cell tower will be the first thing anyone sees when turning off Route 7 into the Historic Center of Gaylordsville. If approved it will be within a mile or less from 4 Historic Sites (see attached map). These sites are: *Brown's Forge* (built 1870), *The Merwinsville Hotel* (1843 and on the National Register of Historic Places), *the George Washington Oak* (recently memorialized with a monument and plaque by the DAR), and *the Old Red Schoolhouse*. I am on the Board of the Merwinsville Hotel and as we work toward restoring the hotel, we envision a historic attraction that, with the Forge, the Oak and the Schoolhouse will be a showplace of life in early America. This eyesore will be the first thing visitors see when approaching both the Merwinsville Hotel and Brown's Forge and will destroy the historic impression of our small village.**
2. Manner and extent to which petitioner proposes to participate: **I will speak at the Siting Counsel hearing on this matter and oppose this cell tower location in any way I can.**


