Re: Application of The Connecticut Light & Power Company to the Connecticut Siting Council for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Construction of the Rood Avenue Substation in Windsor

Dear Mr. Trinks:

Northeast Utilities Service Company on behalf of The Connecticut Light & Power Company ("CL&P") is planning to file an application with the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") for approval to construct a new bulk power substation in the Town of Windsor. This substation, to be known as the Rood Avenue Substation, will increase the capacity of CL&P's distribution system to meet increasing peak-load demands in the Town of Windsor.

Connecticut General Statutes Section 16-50(e) requires an applicant for a new substation to provide the chief elected official of the affected municipality with information relating to the proposed project at least sixty (60) days before filing an application with the Council. To comply with this requirement, we are pleased to present you with the attached Municipal Consultation Filing. It includes a description of the substation, the public need for the project and environmental effects.

Extra copies of the Municipal Consultation Filing are being provided as a courtesy to allow the placement of copies at locations of your choice. We respectfully request that you make appropriate arrangements for these additional copies to be made available for review by the public. We are also sending a copy to the Windsor Library for this purpose.

A copy of the application submitted to the Council will be delivered to you, the Town's Planning and Zoning Commission, the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Commission, as well as to numerous state officials and legislators as required by the Council's governing statutes. Your municipality and its residents will have the opportunity to participate in a Council proceeding on the application, which we plan to submit in November, 2007.

We look forward to working with you during the siting process. If you need additional information or would like to arrange further consultations concerning the Rood Avenue Substation, please contact me at 860-665-6774.
