

Dear Chairman Stein:

Pursuant to Condition 7 of the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council) Decision and Order dated July 20, 2010, The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P) hired an independent environmental inspector to monitor and report on the installation of the overhead transmission system and provide bi-weekly progress reports to the Council. On September 30, 2012, the Manchester to Meekville Junction Project (MMP) facilities were energized and placed in service. As part of the project close-out process, CL&P is now preparing a final report to the Council, as required by regulation, and final right-of-way restoration activities are expected to be completed by November 30, 2012. Therefore, CL&P respectfully requests Council agreement that, except for a final verification in the Spring of 2013 to document the success of the restoration activities, inspections and reports by the independent environmental inspector are no longer required.
