Dear Attorney Kohler:

At a public meeting of the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) held on January 20, 2011, the Council approved the transfer of the Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Certificate) from Phoenix Partnership, LLC to Florida Tower Partners, LLC, subject to an inspection of the facility by Council staff. This approval of transfer is consistent with State law, conditioned on the consent of Florida Tower Partners, LLC to comply with all the terms, limitations, and conditions contained in said Certificate issued on February 25, 2010, and on the timely payment of apportioned assessment charges for the facility under Connecticut General Statute § 16-50v(b)(2).

Furthermore, the Council also granted your request for an extension until June 1, 2011 of Condition 10 of the Decision and Order, which requires at least one carrier to install antennas within 120 days after the tower is operational. MetroPCS has assumed Pocket's lease obligations and is expected to install their antennas on this tower.


Dear Ms. Roberts:

Florida Tower Partners, LLC ("FTP") has recently acquired the wireless telecommunications facility previously owned by Phoenix Partnership, LLC ("Phoenix"), which is located at 50 Devine Street, North Haven, Connecticut (approved as Docket No. 384). Phoenix requests that the Certificate granted by Decision and Order on February 25, 2010 in this Docket be transferred to FTP, and pursuant to the requirements of Connecticut General Statutes Section 16-50k(b), FTP agrees to comply with the terms and conditions contained in that Certificate.

Further, FTP respectfully requests an extension to the deadline set forth in Provision 10 of the Decision and Order. MetroPCS assumed the lease obligations of Pocket Communications on November 1, 2010, and is expected to install its equipment on the facility in the near future. FTP requests an extension to June 1, 2011.

FTP would appreciate it if the Council would consider these matters at its next regularly scheduled meeting.
