
The Department of Transportation (Department), has been working extensively with The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P), to ensure that CL&P is clearly aware of the Department's permit requirements for the installation of sections of their proposed underground transmission facilities within the state roadway and railroad right-of-way. CL&P is required to address the Department's concerns relative to the installation of the proposed underground transmission facilities within highway and rail right-of-way.

The proposed 115kV underground transmission facility will be crossing the railroad owned by the Department. As such, any proposal to cross the railroad must be submitted to Ms. Julie Thomas, Supervisory Property Agent, Bureau of Public Transportation, 50 Union Avenue, New Haven, Connecticut 06519.

Upon approval of the proposed transmission project by the Connecticut Siting Council, CL&P will be required to submit permit applications to the Department. No construction activities will be allowed to commence within the Department's right-of-way until CL&P secures all permits and enters into appropriate license agreement.
