RE: **DOCKET NO. 448** – Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located at Orange Tax Assessor Map 77, Block 3, Lot 1, 831 Derby Milford Road, Orange, Connecticut.

During a special meeting of the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) held on July 29, 2014, the Council ruled on the following matters:

Intervenor Subbloie, et al, Motion for Continuance and Order, dated 7/21/14.

The Intervenors' motion was denied in part as it relates to the postponement of the August 12, 2014 continued evidentiary hearing and was granted in part as it relates to limiting the scope of the August 12, 2014 hearing to continued cross examination of the applicant and to schedule an additional evidentiary hearing date for September 16, 2014, at 1 p.m. The deadline for submitting additional interrogatory questions for the September 16, 2014 public hearing will be September 2, 2014 and the deadline for pre-filed testimony for the September 16, 2014 public hearing will be September 9, 2014.

Request for Intervenor Status under C.G.S. § 16-50n, 4-177a, and 22a-19, for Representative James Maroney, Representative Themis Klarides, Representative Paul Davis and Senator Gayle Slossberg, dated 7/25/14.

The request was granted by the Council and pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50n(c), the Council voted to group these intervenors with the existing Intervenors Subbloie, et al based on the fact that their interests are identical as evidenced in their respective requests for intervenor status and designated Senator Slossberg as the agent for service of notice and documents for the new intervenors. The schedule adopted in the disposition of Intervenors Subbloie, et al Motion for Continuance described above shall apply to the new intervenors.

The Council shall continue the evidentiary hearing for the above-referenced proceeding on Tuesday, August 12, 2014, in Hearing Room One, Ten Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut, beginning at 1:00 p.m.

The hearing shall commence with the continued cross examination of the applicant by the Council to be followed by cross examination of the applicant by the grouped intervenors.

The Council has developed a revised schedule for this proceeding. A copy is attached for your convenience.
