RE: **DOCKET NO. 470** – NTE Connecticut, LLC application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 550-megawatt dual-fuel combined cycle electric generating facility and associated electrical interconnection switchyard located at 180 and 189 Lake Road, Killingly, Connecticut.

The Connecticut Siting Council has scheduled a field review for this docket for October 20, 2016 beginning at 3:30 p.m. **Due to parking constraints near the site, Council members will first meet at the Killingly High School at 226 Putnam Pike, Killingly promptly at 3:00 p.m. at the visitors parking area near the main entrance of the school. Bear right at the fork at the top of school access drive to reach this parking area.** Council members will then carpool to the site for the 3:30 p.m. field review.

Upon arrival at the site, Council members will park in the U-shaped driveway of the existing residence on the power plant property at 189 Lake Road, Killingly. Limited parking may be available for other participants.

The field review will commence at 3:30 p.m. at the area identified as Location 1 & 7. See attached site map. Boots are highly recommended.

A public comment session is scheduled for October 20, 2016 beginning at 6:30 p.m. in the auditorium of the Killingly High School, 226 Putnam Pike, Killingly.
