Question No. 1

Listed below are the data from the May 2010 ISO-New England Seasonal Claimed Capability Report, rounded to two decimal places. Does Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. (Dominion) agree with the numbers listed below? If no, provide the most up to date data.

Net Capability – MW	Summer	Winter
Millstone Point 2	869.11	879.31
Millstone Point 3	1233.40	1237.20

Question No. 2

Are Millstone 2 and 3 boiling water reactors or pressurized water reactors?

Response

Millstone Units 2 and 3 are both pressurized water reactors.

Question No. 3

What are the current Nuclear Regulatory Commission license expiration dates for Millstone 2 and 3.

Response

Millstone Units 2 and 3 operating licenses were renewed on November 25, 2005, for an additional 20 years. The Unit 2 operating license was extended to July 31, 2035, and the Unit 3 operating license was extended to November 25, 2045.

Question No. 4

The ISO New England May 1, 2010 Interconnection Request Queue, Active FERC Tab (under Excel), Line 88, indicates a "Power Station Increase" for a nuclear power plant connected to Millstone Substation in Waterford. Is Millstone planning a power upgrade for one or both of its reactors or planning a new unit? Include the number of megawatts of the project.

Response

Dominion continues to investigate potential opportunities for power increases on its generating units, however, no final decision on any power upgrades for the Millstone Units has been made at this time. Dominion is not planning a new unit at this time.

Question No. 5

Are any other power upgrades planned for Millstone at this time?

Response

Dominion has no other power upgrades planned at this time.
