The following is intended to fulfill such obligations as Connecticut Resources Recovery Authority (CRRA) may have regarding the filing of a report as described in Connecticut General Statute 16-50r. While it is our desire to be comprehensive, we can only make statements in reference to subjects for which we have first hand knowledge.

1. Tabulation of Estimated Peak Loads, Resources and Margins

CRRA owns two generating units (5U and 6U) located at the South Meadows Facility in Hartford, Connecticut. The Claimed Capability of each unit is as follows:


