

15. Provide a visibility analysis on a topographic map that depicts potential visibility of the proposed exhaust stack, including seasonal variations, from all public ways within a one-mile radius of the stack site. Provide photosimulations of the proposed exhaust stack from surrounding roads and residential areas, if applicable. Estimate the number of residences that would have year-round views of the exhaust stack.
16. Page 46 of the application refers to four reports that studied the availability of fuel in Connecticut. Please list the total amounts of recoverable waste wood fuel identified in each report.
17. Is the recoverable waste wood fuel source specific to Connecticut or does it include sources in Massachusetts and Rhode Island? Describe the out-of-state sources and amount of fuel provided by each, if applicable.
18. Provide the dimensions of the main facility components including the exhaust stack, covered wood storage area, power house, and cooling tower.
