
Dear Mr. Rinebold:


Confirming our conversation on March 27, 2007, Clearview Renewable Energy (CRE) continues its strong interest in pursuing the subject Petition before the Council and intends to resume active engagement just as soon as CRE reasonably determines that an Energy Purchase Agreement (EPA) for the proposed Project can and will be successfully secured with Connecticut Light and Power (CL&P), an established intervenor in this Petition. While CRE is extremely pleased with its status as a Connecticut Clean Energy Fund (CCEF) Project "100 Project" (as you may be aware, CRE was among eleven (11) such projects selected under CCEF's Project 100 Program being referred to the utilities for further consideration), it is not immediately clear that all of the Projects selected on March 26th and being referred to the utilities on or about April 6th will be awarded EPAs.

CRE looks forward to initiation of EPA discussions and negotiations with CL&P following CCEF's delivery of its Project 100 selections and we would hope the EPA between CRE and CL&P could be accomplished within sixty (60) days following initiation of negotiations. Accordingly, CRE respectfully requests that the Council keep the subject Petition in an active, but pending status, until such time that CRE is able to formally notify the Council of its interest in resuming processing of the subject Petition. Coincident with this request, CRE waives all regulatory deadline requirements for the Council's actions and decisions in connection with the subject Petition.
