

**REQUEST TO INTERVENE BY**  
**THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY**

The Connecticut Light and Power Company ("CL&P") hereby applies pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. §16-50n(b) and R.C.S.A. §16-50j -15a to be designated as an intervenor in this proceeding. In support of this application, CL&P states as follows:

1. CL&P is a specially chartered Connecticut corporation, with offices at 107 Selden Street, Berlin, Connecticut, and a public service company as defined in §16-1 of the Connecticut General Statutes.

2. CL&P operates and maintains transmission and distribution facilities throughout the State of Connecticut, providing service to approximately 1.1 million customers. CL&P is affected by this proceeding in that the proposed project has potential impacts on the Connecticut electric transmission system, particularly including CL&P's transmission rights-of-way.

Manner in Which the Petitioner is Substantially and Specifically Affected.

3. According to the Petition, two of the three routing options for interconnection of the proposed facility to Bozrah Light and Power's Stockhouse Road Substation would require the use of existing CL&P easements. (See Petition at 2.6-1 - 2.6-3) CL&P seeks to intervene in this proceeding to determine the potential impacts of

such routing options on its existing easements and to protect its interests as it deems necessary.

Petitioner's Proposed Participation

4. CL&P would like to participate in all proceedings in the above-referenced docket. It may provide, amongst other things, prefiled testimony, witnesses, briefs or comments as appropriate.

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

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
