

Dear Mr. Phelps:

This letter is intended to confirm our discussion on September 13, 2007 regarding Clearview Renewable Energy's (CRE) continued desire and commitment to pursue the subject Petition before the Council.

Consistent with our letter to you dated March 27, 2007 we intend to resume Petition-related activity just as soon as CRE reasonably determines that a Renewable Energy Purchase Agreement (EPA) for the proposed Project can be successfully secured with Connecticut Light and Power (CL&P). Since our March 27th letter to you, this determination has advanced to the Department of Public Utilities Control, whose decision on this matter is final. Accordingly, we're pleased to provide you with the following updated CRE EPA progress summary:

- **DPUC Docket No. 07-05-31 Class I Renewable Energy Source Status**
We're pleased to inform the Council that CRE's Class I Renewable Energy Source status was formally established by DPUC in the attached August 22, 2007 Final Decision; and
- **DPUC Docket No. 07-04-27 Review of Long Term Renewable Energy Contracts**
 - Attached is a copy of DPUC's schedule of activities for this Docket, which as you can see, indicates that the Department's *Final Decision* on EPAs will be made on or about December 20, 2007; and
 - The attached copy of the August 21, 2007 joint CL&P/United Illuminating submission to DPUC contains the utilities' independent evaluation of the Project 100 Round 2 candidates selected by the Clean Energy Fund (CCEF) on March 26, 2007 and referred to the utilities for further evaluation on April 9, 2007. We're extremely pleased with the attached joint findings and conclusions by these participating Project 100 utilities and remain hopeful that this compelling submission contributes to a favorable DPUC determination regarding CRE's EPA.



1. Continues to waive all regulatory deadline requirements for Council's actions and decisions in connection with the subject Petition; and
