

TO FIELD REVIEW – 17 Amelia Place

From I-95 southbound

Travel via I-95 South to exit 6 (West Ave)
Turn left off of the exit onto West Ave.
Turn left at the third light onto Selleck Street
Turn right onto Betts Avenue (after a barbed wire fence, at the corner of Salvation Army bldg)
Amelia Place is at the end of Betts Avenue
At the intersection of Amelia Place and Betts Avenue the facility will be straight ahead


TO STAMFORD GOVERNMENT CENTER

From Site

Follow Amelia Place to Bonner Street
Turn left on Bonner Street and follow to intersection with Selleck Street
Turn right onto Selleck Street
Follow Selleck Street to third light and turn left onto Greenwich Avenue
Go under a Railroad bridge
At the light after the RR bridge turn right onto South State St.
Turn left onto Washington Blvd
888 Washington Blvd is on the left (across from a circular apartment building)
Turn left on Tresser Blvd, which is before the Government Center building
Park in garage behind building (no fee – according to SGC staff)

From I-95 southbound

Follow I-95 to exit 8 (Elm Street)
Turn right onto Elm Street
Take 1st left onto Tresser Blvd.
Follow Tresser Blvd. (approximately 0.6 miles) to intersection with Washington Blvd.
Go straight through the intersection with Washington Blvd. (Government Center on the right corner of this intersection)
Park in garage behind building (no fee – according to SGC staff)
