Owen Clark and Robert Erling met Ben Bickford and Mike Carlson of Northeast Utilities for a field review of Petition No. 39, Canton to North Bloomfield substation. All access roads appeared stable and showed no signs of erosion. Woodchips and grass had been used to stabilize the soil in most areas, and has been quite successful. Other areas, namely residential streets such as Weatherby Road and Saddle Ridge Road had been landscaped using a variety of evergreens, shrubs and grass. The landscaping has been done professionally with attractive results and the right-of-way appears to be in excellent condition.

Wetlands along the Farmington River showed no signs of damage. All the remaining materials, such as old poles and hardware noted in the Field Review of June 29, 1982, had been removed during rehabilitation.

The review team found no conditions warranting further surveillance. For this reason, it is recommended that the Development and Management Plan receive final approval.
