Mr. Doocy and Mr. Reid met Mr. Bibbi and Mr. Biondi of NUSCO to review completed Petition No. 59.

Petition No. 59 involves the construction of an Emergency Operations Center (EOC), a building used to monitor conditions within any of the Millstone Nuclear plants during an emergency.

The EOC is located approximately 1.1 miles north of Millstone Unit III west of the access road. This concrete building is 14 feet high, 126 feet long, and 86 feet wide with a 14 foot shielded entrance which includes pressurized door locks. It contains shower rooms for decontaminating personnel, a small kitchen, office space for 70 emergency personnel, city supplied water, air filters, and an emergency generator. The building and parking lot grounds are attractively landscaped with a variety of trees, shrubs, and vines. Areas disturbed by construction are now covered by grass. A hay bale check dam was established along the west edge of the building and parking lot construction areas.

The building is temporarily being used for plant personnel training sessions. A new training center is planned directly southwest of this site. The Millstone Point EOC is essentially identical to the Connecticut Yankee EOC. Final cost is approximately two million dollars.

All construction appears to have been completed as described in the petition. Final approval is recommended.
