Mr. Gelston, Mr. Tait, and Duncan Reid met Messrs. John Moran, Ken Archer, Mike Stone, and Keven Smith of Storer Communications of Clinton, Inc., Mr. Ted Phillips of Brown, Jacobson, Jewett and Landone, and Mr. H.E. Bruce, First Selectman of Killingworth for a field review of Petition No. 75.

This petition involves the installation of an earth station, construction of an equipment enclosure, and the removal of an existing equipment enclosure and generator shelter. The proposed earth station will be ten feet high and 3.7 meters wide, and the proposed equipment enclosure will be approximately 27 feet long, 21 feet wide, and 14 feet high. The earth station will be located a few feet northwest of the existing 372 foot tall head-end tower, and the equipment enclosure will be constructed a few feet east of the tower.

No clearing and no new access will be required. Access to the site is over an existing farm road approximately 1000 feet long. The site is totally surrounded by trees and is not visible from any public roads; however, the upper portions of the existing tower is visible from selected places along route 81 and probably is visible from various viewpoints in the area. The equipment enclosure and earth station will probably not be visible from anywhere off the site itself, and no residences are visible from the site.

The proposed earth station is for satellite reception only, so there will be no change in power density levels at the site.

The Killingworth First Selectman spoke in favor of the proposal.
