Field Review

New Milford, CT.

Chairperson Gloria Pond, Owen Clark, and Robert Erling of the Connecticut Siting Council met Robert Saraday, Vice President of Engineering for New Milford Cablevision, for a field review of Petition No. 111. New Milford Cablevision is petitioning the Council for a ruling that no certificate of environmental compatibility and public need is required for the company's construction of a head-end building off of Ridge Road in New Milford. The building itself is nearly complete, and construction was begun before the company understood it must first seek approval from the Council.

The 27' x 60' steel building will be used to house electronic equipment such as processors and modulators. The company constructed the new building because it is expanding its technological capabilities and will be sharing this head-end with Housatonic Cable Vision Company, and Mid-Connecticut Cablevision Company.

Five towers of various heights now exist on this site, and Mr. Saraday indicated that the company will take two of the poles down after microwave dishes are taken off and placed on an existing 130' tower on the site.

An access road, presently being constructed, will be paved. Council members noted the close proximity of a farm pond to this road, and staff has asked the company to provide the Council with an inland wetlands map of this site.

Mr. Saraday indicated that a small existing electronics building will be taken down, and that the new building would be screened with evergreens.
