



# Family Day Poster Contest

The Family Day 2008 committee will be selecting three different posters to promote Family Day 2008. The winners' art work will be displayed on the official Family Day 2008 website, in various event posters and media event packets as well as being displayed on a banner across the street from the Capitol in September 2008. The winners will be selected from three age categories:

- Elementary School
- Middle School
- High School

**Prizes:** Each of the three winners will receive \$200. In addition, the winners may also receive a family weekend getaway thanks to the efforts of one of our partners, the Connecticut Commission on Culture and Tourism!

**Criteria:** The main criteria is that at least one hand print must be incorporated into the poster image. Utilize bright colors and work should NOT be done in crayons (crayons do not reproduce well).

**Size:** Finished poster must not be larger than 11 X 17 inches.

**Medium:** Any medium can be utilized, except crayons (No crayons - they don't reproduce well). Pen and paper, chalk, markers, watercolors, acrylic paint, oil, etc. and any paper or poster board.

**Contest Ages:** anyone in elementary, middle or high school may enter. The judging will be based upon the three age groups and three posters will be selected to represent this years' Family Day 2008 in media.

**Rules:** Posters must be submitted to Deanna Lia (contact information provided below) by May 15, 2008. The Family Day Committee will judge the posters and make their selections and decision by May 30th, 2008.

**Deadline for Submission:** May 15, 2008

**Requirements and Waivers:** Posters become the property of Family Day and will not be returned. Also, winners must allow their likenesses and their posters to be utilized in the promotion of Family Day, in this or any year, or any way the committee sees fit.
