



American Corporate Partners is a nationwide mentoring program that matches employees from some of the nation's largest corporations and universities with OIF/OEF veterans for the purpose of mentoring, networking, and career counseling. Transitioning from military service to the civilian sector can be difficult, but ACP is dedicated to helping veterans develop the valuable relationships, key skills, and action plans needed for success in private enterprise.

Anyone who has served on active duty since 2001 is eligible to participate, with preference given to those who have deployed in support of OIF/OEF and those with service-connected disabilities. Surviving spouses and primary caregivers of those veterans who have been severely wounded are also encouraged to apply. **Participation is free.**

Veterans are matched one-on-one with a mentor, who is a business leader from a major corporation, according to their preferences. They will meet with a mentor who will provide them with the opportunity to leverage their military skills and experiences in their career development.
