

## BROOKFIELD, CT VETERANS MEMORIAL






In 1989 the Brookfield VFW established a memorial at the entrance of Williams Park and placed there a wooden tablet with all the names of Brookfield residents who served in WWII. In 1992, with the help of private organizations and civic groups, they reconfigured the memorial with the addition of a large granite obelisk and flag pole. These new elements were dedicated on Veterans Day to the men and women of Brookfield who served, and will serve, in our country's Armed Services in the defense of our freedom. Subsequently, Memorial Bricks with veterans names engraved on them have been added to this memorial site. Additionally, a plaque has been placed there to honor all those killed on September 11, 2001.
