VETERANS MEMORIALS



World War 1 had come to an end and the selectmen were authorized to erect and maintain a suitable memorial to the men and women who had served in the War. This granite memorial can be seen on the church lawn on a site near the road.

In 1947 a committee was appointed to establish a permanent memorial honoring veterans of WWII This memorial is also on the church lawn.

A memorial stone honoring the town's Korean and Vietnam veterans was dedicated on Memorial Day 1978. It stands on the church lawn.
