

## NORTH CANAAN, EAST CANAAN, CT VETERANS MEMORIALS



The DOUGHBOY of North Canaan was erected in front of the old town hall in 1928. It was created by a local metal worker in bronze at a cost of \$1,250.00. Although the town hall has moved, the Doughboy still stands, and is the site of our Memorial Day celebrations.

The names of Canaan Vets who served in WWI, WWII, Korea and Vietnam are listed in bronze plates.



An older monument (right) stands in East Canaan, and celebrates the Spanish American & Civil War Vets.
