


SOUTH WINDSOR, CT VETERANS' MEMORIALS

South Windsor Veteran's Memorial Park is located on Pleasant Valley Road off Ellington Road and Route 5 in South Windsor.



Veterans Memorial Park has a permanent brick sculpture, in a patio type setting, of an eagle with outstretched wings at the head of a walkway. Resident veterans and families of veterans purchased bricks, inscribed with the veteran's name and military service, which are placed within the body of the eagle and the walkway leading up to the eagle. Bricks can be purchased at any time during the year and will be placed just before Memorial Day and Veterans Day.

There are 5 monuments dedicated to town residents who lost their lives while serving in their country in World War I, World War II, Korea, and Vietnam. The monuments are inscribed with the names of the individuals who lost their lives. There is a town monument dedicated to all veterans. The area is further enhanced with 2 lighted flagpoles and 2 granite benches to sit and reflect upon. This year, 2 "Memorial Islands" were planted at the entrance to Veterans Memorial Park, with plantings and a miniature sculpture of a combat soldier.
