WARREN SOLDIERS MONUMENT, Civil War

Location: Hyde Park, downtown Stafford Springs

Description: 31 Foot granite shaft with bronze female figure in front 1861 – 1865, with text One Nation Indivisible With Liberty And Justice For All

History: Gift of Civil War Veteran Colonel Charles Warren to the town of his nativity. Dedicated May 1924 Web Site:

Location: Stafford Cemetery, Monson Road RT 32, Stafford

Description: Large Cannon atop

History: Gift of Orrin Converse Esq. Dedicated May 1897

Location: Warren Memorial Town Hall, Stafford Springs

Description: 4 Foot X 3 Foot cast bronze plaque listing Veteran's Names. From the Town of Stafford. Restored in 2007 by VFW Post 9990

STAFFORD WALL OF HONOR OF THE 20TH CENTURY, Phase I and II

Location: Olympic Circle off of RT 32 / RT 190 at the entrance to Olympic Park Stafford.

Description: 3 granite monuments with bronze

plaques listing the names of the men and women from Stafford that served during the conflicts of the 20th century, flag pole, brick walkway with names, and Committee Plaque. Town Committees designed, raised

funds and erected a permanent Memorial recognizing the citizens from Stafford who served and those who were killed in action. Dedicated November 2005. WWII Cannon added to site in 2008



MEMORIAL FIELD HOUSE, World War II

Location: Olympic Park Athletic fields off RT 32 / RT 190

Description: Building with attached cast bronze plaque that houses locker rooms adjacent to the Athletic fields

History: Given by the citizens of Stafford




IN MEMORIAM, World War II

Location: Traffic Island at the intersection of East Street RT 19 and Bradway Road in Staffordville

Description: Concrete monument with attached bronze plaque and flag pole

History: Given by the community of Staffordville

Location: Stafford High School, Levinthal Run off of Orcuttville Rd. RT 319 Stafford Description: 5ftX4 ft display case Plaque w/5 seals of the Armed Forces Honoring Stafford Veterans History: BSA Eagle Scout Project by Timothy Dillon, Donated February 2009



IN MEMORY OF PFC JEFFERY BRAUN (right)

Location: Stafford Library Traffic Circle, Levinthal Run off Orcuttville Rd RT 319

Description: 1 ftX 1 ft Fieldstone monument with bronze plaque, perennial flower garden surrounding the flag pole in memory of the first soldier from Stafford to give his life for his country while serving in Iraq.

History: BSA Eagle Scout Project by Mark Bachiochi. Donated to the Stafford in 2004.



AMERICAN LEGION PODIUM (left)

Location: American Legion Post 26, RT 32 Monson Road, Stafford

Description: Fieldstone podium, torch, flag pole and granite monument

History: Erected in 1973 in loving memory of our dearly departed Comrades

VFW POST 9990 WILLIAM GAVINE MEMORIAL DISPLAY CASE (right)

Location: Stafford Historical Society Museum, Spring Street, Stafford Springs Description: 5 ftX 4 ft X 1.5 Foot glass display case with brass plaque filled with past Post Commander Gavine's Military and Post 9990 Memorabilia. Donated to Museum in memory of late Post Commander in April 2006
