### **Connecticut Veterans Memorial**

The Connecticut Veterans Memorial West Hartford is a unique testimonial dedicated to all members of the Armed Services who served the United States of America beginning with the earliest conflict in our country's history, the King Philip War, up to the present Global War on Terror. On May 21, 2006 a Dedication Day ceremony was held at the site located at the intersection of Farmington Avenue and North Main Street in heart of West Hartford Center.

This Veterans Memorial is a sculptural expression of time and emotion that commemorates the history of all wars. The Memorial is constructed of blocks of polished black granite in the form of a circle. At each point along the wall when our Armed Forces went into conflict, the smooth circular wall is violently broken, and the names of the West Hartford veterans who gave their lives during that conflict are engraved on the Wall of Peace.

Adjacent to the wall, is the Walk of Remembrance which comprises solid granite pavers with the names of veterans who served in the Armed Services, both present and past. The outer circumference of the Walk of Remembrance forms a timeline of local and national historical events.
