

Intro to CSEC/DMST for Law Enforcement in CT

Instructions for Application for TOT

In an effort to increase awareness among law enforcement personnel about Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (CSEC) and Domestic Minor Sex Trafficking (DMST) affecting children and youth in Connecticut, a Training of Trainers (TOT) will be developed. This training entitled "Intro to CSEC/DMST for Law Enforcement in CT" is being provided to increase statewide capacity for educating law enforcement staff thereby improving their competencies in working effectively with this vulnerable population. We are seeking individuals in the public and private sector to expand the number of trainers to teach this curriculum.

Applicant Qualification:

- Training Experience
- Population Experience
- Content Experience

This is a competitive process that requires completion of the following:

- Application – will need agency and/or supervisory signed approval.
- The 2nd day of training includes "teach backs" which will be evaluated by the current training faculty.
- Co-leading to involve one full training of the 2 ½ hr. curriculum. Additional co-leading of the training may be necessary should there be concerns.
- Trainer Selection Process – selection and final approval to become a trainer in this curriculum from the current training faculty.
- Trainers will be selected utilizing specific criteria that will be scored during the process.

Training Commitment:

- Two full-days TOT including module teach backs
- Co-lead at least one full training (2 ½ hr. curriculum). If necessary, additional co-leading opportunities may be mandated.
- Four (4) complete training sessions are expected from each trainer per year
- Participate in 1 faculty meeting per year
