Severity of Parole Violation Matrix

To use this grid, locate the behavior from those listed in the left hand column. For the chosen behavior, follow that row, moving to the right until you locate the best descriptor. Each descriptor column corresponds to a level of seriousness, minor, moderate or major as noted at top.

Violation of curfew (in excess of ½ hour)	1 - 3 per month	More than 3 per month or location unknown	n/a
Leaving home without permission or whereabouts unknown	Few hours to 1 overnight	More than 1 overnight	n/a
Failure to cooperate with household expectations	1 - 3 per month	More than 3 per month or unremitting	n/a
School attendance issues*	1 per month	Consecutive days or 3 or more per month	n/a
Failure to keep appointments with Juvenile Justice Social Worker	1 per month	More than 1 per month	Full refusal to meet with Juvenile Justice Social Worker
Association with negative peers	Limited contact	Occasional, intentional contact	Ongoing with evidence of illegal activities
Gang involved	Contact but unaffiliated	Affiliated but limited involvement	Affiliated and actively engaging in activities to support the gang life
Non-compliance with Services	Not impacting service delivery per provider	Impacting efficacy of service per provider	Rendering service ineffective per provider
Possession of drugs or alcohol or positive drug screen	N/A	1 time	Repeat
Misdemeanor arrest	N/A	Isolated arrest	Multiple arrests
Failure to appear at court for arrest	N/A	Isolated or minor charge	Repeated or serious charge
School suspension*	N/A	Chronic minor behaviors or isolated serious incident	Aggressive or seriously disruptive to school community
School expulsion *	N/A	Drug or alcohol incident	Dangerous behavior
Arrest: charge against person, felony	N/A	N/A	Any
Possession of Weapon	N/A	No Intent to harm	Known Intent to harm

*When determining sanctions due to school misbehavior, consideration must be given to whether school interventions have adequately addressed the behavior. If so, override may be considered.
