Removal Options

Once it has been determined that a child needs to be removed from his own home, this action may be taken in one of five ways:

- Orders of Temporary Custody from Superior Court-Juvenile Matters
 - Orders of Temporary Custody from Superior Court upon arrest of parent or guardian
 - Orders of Temporary Custody from Probate Court
 - Ninety-Six (96) hour hold – hospital
 - Ninety-Six (96) hour hold – DCF

Court Approval to Move Out-of- State

Whenever temporary custody has been awarded to the Department of Children and Families by any court, those child(ren) cannot be removed from the State without the Court's approval.
