


Naloxone (Narcan) Overview

More people died from drug overdoses in 2014 than in any year on record. The majority of drug overdose deaths involve an opioid (including prescription opioid pain relievers and heroin). The good news is that we have saved over 200 lives since February 2015 by using Narcan.

Dr. Wolfe will provide an overview of Naloxone (Narcan), one of the few medications currently used to treat drug overdoses. The overview will be followed by a question and answer period.
