

2010 CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

- CONTINUING EDUCATION (CE) COURSES MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE THE EXPIRATION DATE OF YOUR LICENSE IN 2010.
- **DO NOT** SUBMIT PROOF OF CONTINUING EDUCATION WITH THE 2010 APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL.
- ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES MUST BE RETAINED FOR 3 YEARS IN THE EVENT OF STATE AUDIT SELECTION.

REQUIREMENTS FOR BROKERS AND SALESPEOPLE

A. Complete 12 hours of Continuing Education courses at an approved school.

The courses shall consist of the following:

1. 3-hours of CT Buyer Agency: Mandatory Course for 2010 CE Cycle
2. 3-hours of CT Disclosure, RESPA, and Law Update: Mandatory Course for 2010 CE Cycle
3. 6-hours of Real Estate elective courses

EXCEPTION FROM CONTINUING EDUCATION (CE)

Brokers- If you passed the Connecticut Broker full licensing examination between 4/1/2008 and 3/31/2010, you do not need to take the continuing education courses.

Salespeople- If you passed the Connecticut Salesperson full licensing examination between 6/1/2008 and 5/31/2010, you do not need to take the continuing education courses.
